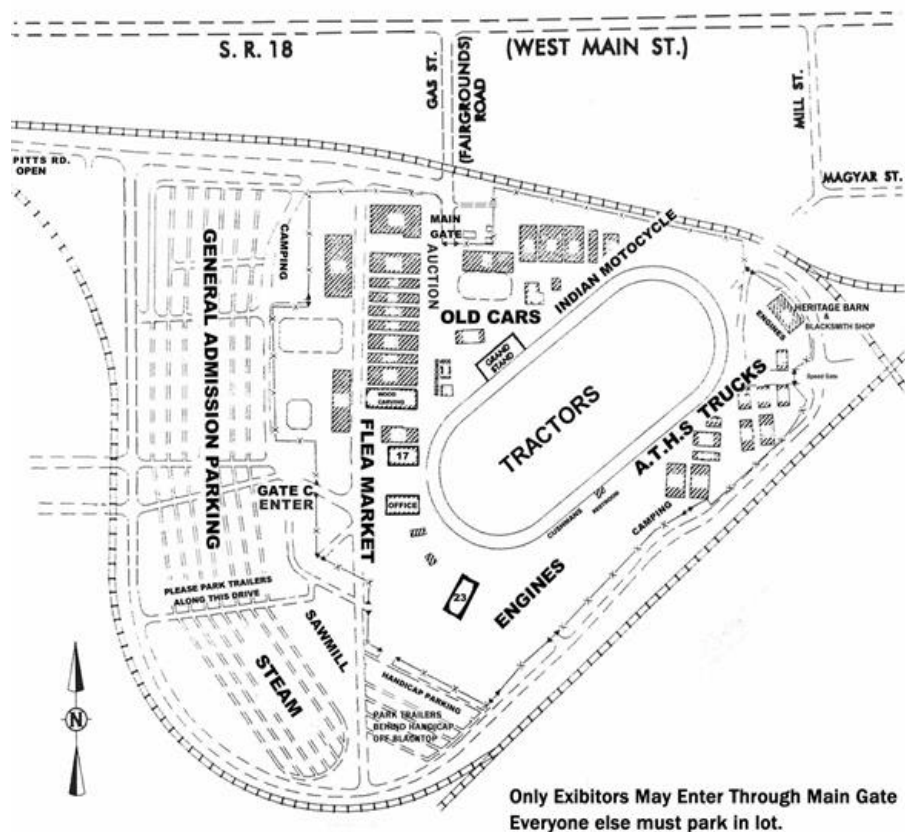

EXHIBITORS

Please register your items. It's free! And you don't need to be a club member! We are giving plaques to the first 500 people to register. **The registration table is in Building 19.** It will be open 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM Friday and Saturday and 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM Sunday.

ADMISSION

There is a \$3.00 admission charge (children under 12 accompanied by adult – free) All exhibitors get in free, but **passes** will be needed if you want to go in and out each day without your display. Pick them up at Building 19.

CAMPING POLICIES

The camping fee is \$40 for the weekend. The LaGrange Engine Club has defined a camper as “any motor home, trailer, truck camper or a tent with a capacity for three or more people.”. This means that the only people who do not have to pay to stay overnight are people sleeping in their car/truck or someone with a very small tent. The \$40 fee will include electricity where available. There is no discount for spaces without electricity. A camping permit will be issued at Building 19 and it must be displayed at your campsite. No camper set up before Wednesday @ 5:00 PM.

LIABILITY

Neither the Lagrange Engine Club nor the Lorain County Agricultural Society are responsible or liable for damage or theft of any equipment or items on the fairgrounds either before, during or after the show.

LAGRANGE ENGINE CLUB MEMBERSHIP

The LaGrange Engine Club is a non-profit organization formed in 1970. It is dedicated to the restoration, preservation, and display of antique farm and industrial machinery and engines. Meetings are held at 7:30 PM on the second Thursday of each month, with the exception of December, at the Lorain County Metro Parks Carlisle Visitor Center, 12882 Diagonal Road, Dues are collected each year at the annual show. Membership is only \$5.00. Membership applications may be filled out at the registration table in Building 19. **Exhibitors need not be members.**

FLEA MARKET

The flea market begins at the north end of the fairground paralleling main drive and runs to the south side of Building 23 and in buildings 23 and 17. If you are interested in bringing things to the flea market next year contact Carol Schmitkons (440 233 6828) or see www.lagrangeengineclub.com for details & an aerial map of the flea market sites.

CONGESTION IN THE SMALL ENGINE AREA

No one is allowed to setup before 5pm Wednesday. Anyone roping off areas must clearly mark their site with their name and phone number. Doing this does not automatically insure that the site will be yours. The club has the right to re-size or move any display. Individuals whose displays are made up of mostly items for sale will be charged a fee based on the amount of area that part of their display takes up and asked to move to the flea market area next year.

HATS AND SHIRTS

LaGrange Engine Club hats, shirts and calendars are available for sale at the registration building 19.

EXHIBITORS AND VISITORS

- All exhibits must be operated in a safe manner, with barriers erected to exclude the public from operating machinery.
- No exhibit may be left running without supervision.
- Each exhibitor should bring appropriate fire protection equipment.
- Radio-controlled models are not to be operated on the grounds.
- Pets must be on a leash and controlled at all times.

DRIVING ON THE FAIR GROUNDS

- **No one without a valid driver's license and insurance is permitted to operate any motorized vehicle anywhere on the fairgrounds.** If you have a golf cart or any type of personal transportation vehicle proof of insurance will be required. Parents, please understand that you are responsible for all minors you bring to the show. This means minors may not operate any type of vehicle without direct adult supervision. You must be riding with them or in control at all times. This includes garden tractors and any motorized vehicle.
- Bicycles, mini-bikes, scooters, roller blades, skateboards, ATV's and all vehicles with handle bars cannot be used for transportation around the grounds. Antique vehicles (25 years and older) and reproductions are exempted. Unique vehicles may be exempted by special permission.
- Anyone driving in a unsafe manner or at high speed will be barred from the grounds.

DRIVING IN THE FLEA MARKET

- Personal Transportation Vehicles widest point cannot exceed 66 inches.
- Mower decks and other extensions must be removed from garden tractors if they are used for personal transportation.

AFTER HOURS AND CAMPING

- Quiet time will be from 24:00 Hrs (12am) to 04:00 Hrs (4am). No loud music, disturbances or use of motorized vehicles.
- No alcoholic beverages or firearms are allowed on the grounds.
- No open campfires, all fires must be contained.
- All campers must have a fire extinguisher.

The LaGrange Engine Club reserves the right to remove any person or persons from the show grounds (Lorain County Fairgrounds) at any time at the staff's discretion.
